Performance Rooms

We are using performance sites rather than room numbers. Please note that Band sites are located on around the MPR in the middle school, String and Piano Sites are in the high school music area and Vocal sites are in the first classrooms of the high school. All sites except site 7 are on the same level. There is an elevator near the homeroom.

All sights except 7 (clavinova) will have acoustic pianos tuned to A=440. Adequate chairs and stands for the largest ensemble in each room will be provided.

The Performing Arts Center (PAC) will house woodwind ensembles and Jazz Ensemble in the morning and vocal ensembles in the afternoon.

There is a classroom (2225) designated for vocal warm-up near the vocal performance rooms. All instrumental warm-ups will be housed in the MS gym, which will also serve as the homeroom for all schools. Security will be on site in the homeroom. PLEASE BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR HOMEROOM AREA BEFORE LEAVING FOR THE DAY SO THAT NOTHING IS LEFT BEHIND.

Equipment furnished

Site 11 will have the following equipment: four timpani, bass drum, orchestra bells, xylophone, marimba, and chime. (You supply anything else, including mallets)

Site 5am/8pm will have a PA system with 4 microphones and stands, extension chords, chairs, stands, drum set and acoustic piano.

Parking and Entrances

Please park in either the northwest faculty lot on the corner of 15th and Oak Creek Parkway or the student parking lot off of Oak Creek Parkway to the east of the HS. Enter the building through doors 9 (main HS entrance), 29 (HS field house), 34 (back between the HS and MS near the HS music wing).

For those with large equipment (basses, tubas, drum sets, amps) please drive up the back access rode around the student lot and unload at door 42 directly to the MS Gym (homeroom). Please park back down in the student lot after unloading.

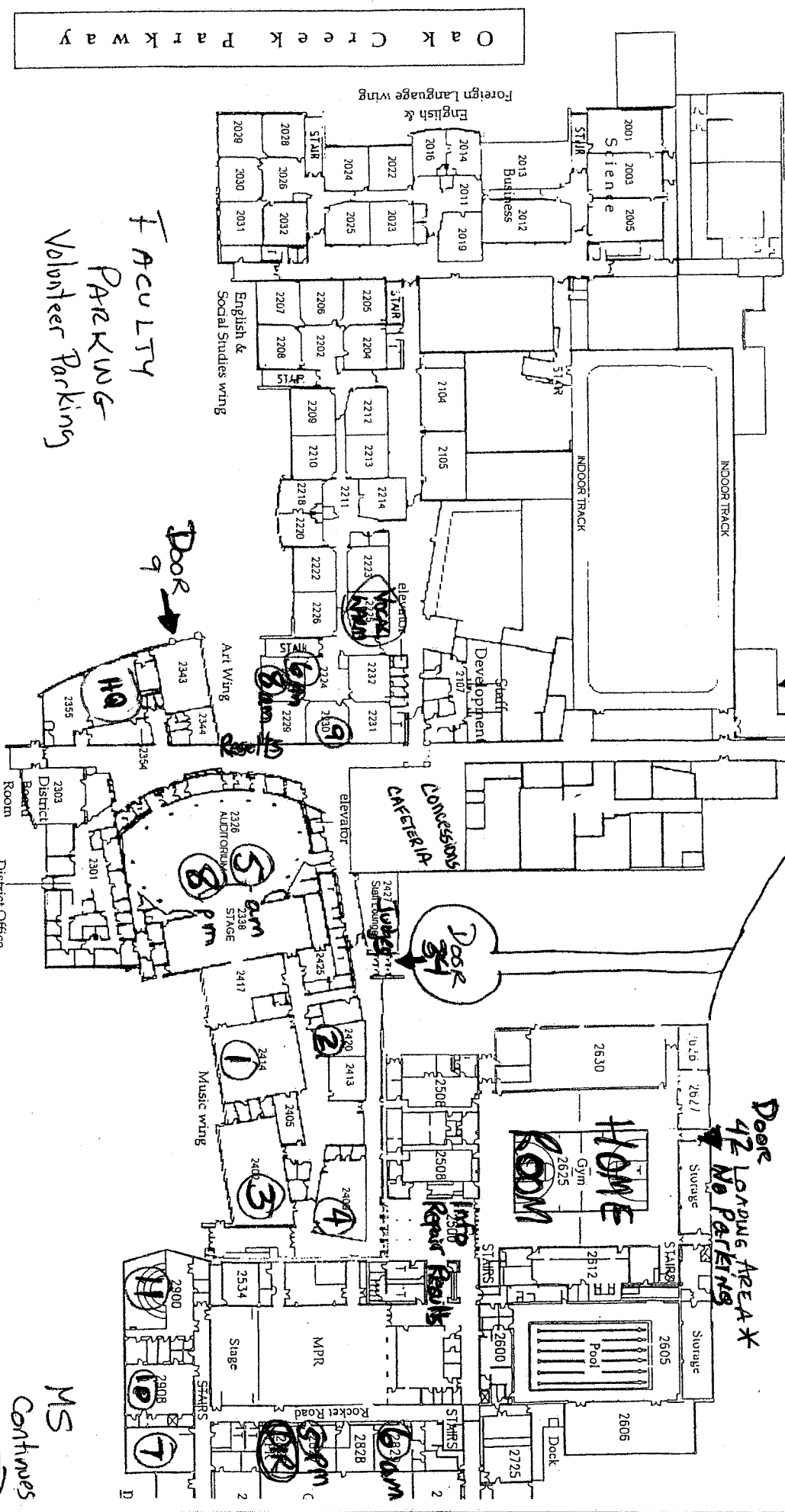
